

Institutional Effectiveness Committee (IE Committee)

Context: During TSC's inaugural year operating independently from the partnership, institutional effectiveness continues to be a critical process for continuous evaluation and improvement of all TSC units, functions, services and programs. The institutional effectiveness process at TSC begins with the mission statement and strategic plan, which provides the focus and scope of the college's activities. The extensive strategic planning process that was undertaken beginning in November 2011, which culminated with the TSC Board of Trustees approval of the College's strategic plan, *Vision 2017*, served as the implementation of TSC's institutional effectiveness process. As a result, *Vision 2017* now serves as the foundation for TSC's allocation of resources for activities, programs, and personnel.

During the fall 2013 semester, institutional goals from *Vision 2017* are being further defined with embedded performance measures and standards that will be tracked and monitored to determine the extent to which each goal and its supporting activities and expected outcomes are attained. These four goals, with their corresponding strategic directions, form the cornerstone that supports the stability and continuity of institutional effectiveness at TSC.

Purpose: The purpose of the IE Committee is to provide a systematic peer review process of activities associated with the College's Institutional Effectiveness Process.
