


Saving Exported ExamView QTI Files to Respondus

1. Locate the QTI file exported from ExamView.



2. Extract the contents of the .zip folder. Take note of where the extracted file is located.




3. In Respondus, click the **Open** button.

5. Change the file type to **IMS QTI questions** in the lower-right hand side of the window.





- 6. Find the folder that was **<u>extracted</u>** from the QTI folder.
- 7. Enter the sub-folders "Test File Names" > QIZ0M> Data.
- 8. Locate the file "questionDB" and then click open.
