

Enabling LockDown Browser for a Quiz

1. From the Course Navigation in Canvas, select **LockDown Browser**.



- 2. You may be asked to Authorize LockDown Browser. If so, click Authorize.
- 3. A list of quizzes will be displayed.
 - Quizzes labeled with **Required** require students to use LockDown Browser.
 - Quizzes labeled with **Not Required** do not require students to use LockDown Browser.
- 4. Click the icon. Then click **Modify Settings**.



5. Select "Require Respondus LockDown Browser for this exam".



6. Click Save and Close.

LockDown Browser is now enabled for this quiz.


Advanced Settings

- The first setting will prevent students from exiting the browser until the exam is completed.
- The second setting will allow students to take the exam with an iPad, using the free LockDown Browser app.
- The third setting will allow specific students to access the exam with screen reader accessibility programs.
- The fourth and fifth settings allow instructors to provide students with a calculator or print function in the LockDown Browser toolbar.




Enabling Respondus Monitor

- 1. Click the icon. Then click **Modify Settings**.
- 2. Enable Respondus LockDown Browser.
- 3. Select **Require Respondus Monitor** for this exam.



4. Select the startup options you would like to use for the exam.



Note: Clicking **Preview** will give you a summary of each option.

5. After selecting your startup options, click **Save and Close**.
