Canvas: Assignments/Quizzes

Presenter: Ms. Julie Ontiveros

Assignments include Quizzes, graded Discussions setup, and online submissions (i.e. files, images, text, URLs, etc.). Assignments in Canvas can be used to challenge students' understanding and help assess competency by using a variety of media. The Assignments page will show your students all of the Assignments that will be expected of them and how many points each is worth.

Canvas: Grading and SpeedGrader/Course Statistics

Presenter: Mr. Michael Doñes

This session will cover the various options instructors have to grade items in Canvas. SpeedGrader allows you to view and grade student assignment submissions in one place using a simple point scale or complex rubric. Some document assignments can be marked up for feedback directly within the submission. Instructors can pull a variety of reports from Canvas. Course analytics will show you activity, assignment submissions, grades, and students. You can view analytics in both active and concluded courses.

Canvas: Interface and Modules

The Canvas user interface has 3 components (dashboard, global navigation, and sidebar). The dashboard is utilized to provide a high level overview of your courses. From the dashboard, one can receive notifications such as announcements, discussion groups, and assignments.

Modules allow you to organize your content to help control the flow of your course. Modules are used to organize course content by weeks, units, or a different organizational structure that works for your course. With modules, you are essentially creating a one-directional linear flow of what you would like your students to do.

Canvas Tips and Tricks: Round Table Discussion

Project responses up on a screen in front of class, and this low-pressure way of getting everyone to contribute also makes students feel empowered.
