	• Provide proof of bacterial meningitis vaccination no later than 10 calendar days before the beginning of school. *Texas state law requires that entering students show evidence of receiving a bacterial meningitis vaccination or booster dose during the five (5) year period prior to enrollment. The law allows for some exceptions. Information is also available through the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.

	• The state of Texas requires all students enrolling in college to meet the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) . Submit T.S.I. test scores or provide official documentation for Texas Success Initiative (TSI) exemption or compliance (TAKS/STAR test scores or official college transcript).

	• The Office of Admissions & Records provides the immigration document (I-20) necessary to obtain F1 or F3 student visa at the U.S. Consulate/ Embassy. TSC must receive complete documentation before issuing I-20.
