

ADDENDUM N. 2

"Pest Control Services"

TSC RFP 19-13

The following changes are hereby incorporated into the Request for Proposal "Pest Control Services" All proposal's statements submitted for consideration shall be bound by the information contained in this addendum.

***Item Section and Description**

Item 1, Section 7 of the RFP document, Description of Services. The paragraph number 3 should be replaced as follow:

3. Keep the College facilities, referenced herein, environmentally pest free inclusive to all termite, fleas, bugs, mosquitoes, moths, hornets, wasps, ants, spiders, crickets, gnats, mice, rats, roaches, silverfish, bed bugs and anything else that could be construed as a pest, insect/or rodent. In addition, rodent infestations, ant mounds, and wasp/hornet nests located adjacent (exterior) to the buildings are included.

3. Keep the College facilities, referenced herein, environmentally pest free including rats, mice, roaches, ants, silverfish, wasp, crickets, and scorpions **"All pests service"** in all TSC facilities. Termites, mosquitoes, fleas, bees, snakes, and other pest not listed will require a quote by vendor as outlined in price schedule. The control of these pests will include the prevention of re-infestation, as well as any existing infestation.

Item 2, Section 7 of the RFP document, Description of Services. The following services have been included as part of the scope of work:

10. The awarded Respondent shall be responsible for advising the TSC management about any structural, sanitary, or procedural modifications that would reduce pest food, water, harborage, or access. TSC will not hold the Contractor responsible for carrying out structural modifications as part of the pest control effort. However, minor applications of caulk and other sealing materials by the contractor to eliminate pest harborage or access, such as spot caulking points of entry is encouraged upon approval of caulking and sealing material.

11. The awarded Respondent shall be responsible for applications of pesticides according to the label. All pesticides used must be registered with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and by the State of Texas. Transport, handling, and use of all pesticides shall be in strict accordance with the manufacturer's label instructions and all applicable Federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

12. Chemicals to be used shall conform to all Federal, State, and Local ordinances. Special care shall be used to reduce the possibility of accidents to humans and domestic animals.

13. Additional visits and treatments shall be made as they are deemed necessary without additional fees. Twenty four hour response for emergency calls and forty eight hour for all others.

Item 3, Section 9 of the RFP document, Schedule. The following paragraphs shall be removed from the section as follow:

9. Schedule

Provide monthly service to all kitchen areas (2 total) located at both Center for Early Childhood Studies; must be scheduled after 5:30 p.m.

Provide quarterly service for the full control of all pest at all locations. Pest control applications must be provided both inside and outside of buildings.

Provide annual service for fleas for both inside and outside of the buildings; provide preventive treatment for termites on all buildings.

Provide special treatment if pests are noted on the covered buildings between services. Pest control includes bee treatment when a hive is identified.
