Workshop and Presentation Descriptions

Turnitin: (Workshop)

You want to promote academic integrity in your classroom, as well as evaluate student work and provide feedback. This session is for you. This presentation will provide an overview of the Turnitin Tool, and introduce you to its robust features.

Google Docs: (Workshop)

Want to learn about Google Forms and other Google Doc tools and how to integrate these tools in your Learning studio courses? This session will cover Google Forms, as well as, other Google Docs tools to simplify many of your teaching tasks and do more things than you thought possible in the classroom.

Introduction to Classroom Applications: (Presentation)

Wondering how to make your classroom more interactive, immersive, and engaging? This is the presentation for you. This presentation will introduce you to three (3) apps that you are able to utilize with your phone or tablet. Apps being presented: Bamboo paper, learning catalytics, and itunesU.

Web 2.0 teaching tools: (Presentation)

Learn about some really nifty Web 2.0 tools you can use with your students to make your classes more interactive! We will visit several Web 2.0 tool websites and let you try them out.

Good Elements of Course Design: (Presentation)

The Doc Sharing tool can be used as a central location to share documents (powerpoints, notes, studyguides, etc.) with your students.
