1. Scholarship application
2. Typed personal statement

Applicants must be meeting the following requirements:

- The applicant shows sufficient academic ability to enable him or her to complete courses of study necessary to graduate from the educational institution selected by him or her and which will admit him or her as a student.
- The applicant has such character, good citizenship or motivation to obtain an education that he or she may be expected to work hard and seriously to continue and complete his or her education.
- The applicant exhibits need for financial assistance to enable him or her to complete his or her course of studies and can demonstrate such fact by the essay submitted with the application.

Nepotism Statement

Texas Education Code, Rule §22.404

State law requires that each student identify any relation to a current Texas Southmost College Board of Trustees. It is a class B misdemeanor to file a false statement. A student who is related to a current Texas Southmost College Board of Trustees is prohibited from receiving scholarships unless:

- The scholarship is granted by a private organization or third party not affiliated with the institution of higher education;
- The scholarship is awarded exclusively on the basis merit;
- The scholarship is an athletic scholarship; or
- The relationship is not within the third degree by consanguinity or the second degree by affinity.
